





# Steam Mills and Woodside Federation

## **Subject Leadership**

Article 28 Every child has the right to an education. Primary education must be free and different forms of secondary education must be available to every child. Discipline in schools must respect children's dignity and their rights. Richer countries must help poorer countries achieve this.

Article 29 Education must develop every child's personality, talents and abilities to the full. It must encourage the child's respect for human rights, as well as respect for their parents, their own and other cultures, and the environment.

At the Steam Mills and Woodside Federation, we have expanded our subject leadership across the three schools: Soudley Primary School, Steam Mills Primary School and Woodside Primary School (all based in the Forest of Dean). This allows our teachers to focus on one curriculum area, to monitor and develop, as well as provide opportunities to collaborate across the three schools. It has been important for the Governors and Senior Leadership Team to enhance the curriculums across the schools by sharing good practice and resources, whilst allowing each school to maintain its unique identity; this allows our teachers to access quality CPD and expertise for so our pupils can have the best possible education.

Each of the schools has identified core drivers that they want to underpin their curriculums with, and although they differ slightly school to school, there are many overlaps which are synonymous with our Federation's vision.
