






In Hedgehogs class this week...

In Geography we are learning about maps, so in forest school this week, we followed a map of Soudley on a walk around the village. We walked past some of our houses and noticed some landmarks e.g. the war memorial, bus stops, pub and church and added them to our map.

In maths, year 2 have been consolidating number, year 1 have been subtracting single digits, 10, and 9 from numbers to 20, Reception have been learning how to use a rekenrek and preschool have been learning 1-5.

This week in Moles class...

This week, Year 3 and 4 have wrapped up their multiplication unit and are now moving on to division. They'll be using what they've learned in multiplication to help them tackle this next step.

In English, the children have been continuing their diary entries from the perspective of Hogarth, a character from *The Iron Man*. It's been great to see them getting creative and really thinking about how Hogarth would feel and react in different parts of the story. We've read two more poems this week: *Woodpecker* and *The Grey Seal*. The children have enjoyed exploring different poetic techniques like acrostic structure, alliteration, personification and rhyme. They've also been looking at the hidden meanings and messages within each poem.

In science, KS2 had lots of fun testing their planned experiments to find out how far a toy car travels on different surfaces. There were lots of interesting results and great scientific thinking all round!

Our learning about Pentecost has continued in RE. The children have been exploring what Christians believe about the Kingdom of God and the significance of this special event.

In Art, the children have been developing their continuous line drawings and thinking carefully about which background works best with their artwork. There's been lots of thoughtful discussion and creativity on display!

It's been a slightly different kind of week in Otters Class, as our Year 6 children have been sitting their SATs tests. They've shown great focus and resilience, and we're incredibly proud of the effort they've put in — both in the lead-up and during the tests themselves.

On Wednesday, Year 5 pupils visited The Dean Academy for a PE tournament. They took part in tag rugby, football rounders, and football matches. The children showed fantastic teamwork and resilience, especially when faced with some tricky opposition — a brilliant effort all round!
