It has been assessment week this week for our year 2s, working hard with their reading and maths "fun booklets". No assessments for Year 1 or Receptions this week so they have been keeping out of the way so as not to distract the Year 2s.

Year 2 have also been trying their best in maths where they are finding subtraction tricky. In English the year 1s and 2s are continuing to create a walkers guide to Soudley. It will be complete with map, points of interest and fun facts.






