



Otters Terms 3 and 4 2025 - 2026

<p>English ~ Reading As well as reading across the curriculum we will have dedicated guided reading sessions. Years 3 and 4 will have focus texts related to the theme of 'Robin Hood' and 'Arts and Artists'. Years 5 and 6 are focusing on 'Bright stars of black history' and 'If' by Rudyard Kipling. All year groups will interrogate these texts using VIPER questions and reading dogs.</p>	<p>Science During Terms 3 and 4 we will be covering the themes of Animals including humans and the circulatory system.</p> 	<p>RE During Term 3 Years 3 and 4 will be looking at the key question 'Do all Christians believe and behave in the same way' with Years 5 and 6 looking at 'How does the Torah influence Jewish people today?' RE During Term 3 Years 3 and 4 will be looking at the key question 'Do all Christians believe and behave in the same way' with Years 5 and 6 looking at 'How does the Torah influence Jewish people today?' When we move to Term 4 Years 3 and 4 will investigate 'What do Muslims believe about God and how do they respond?' and Years 5 and 6 have the question 'Why might the belief that Jesus 'saved' people be so important for many Christians?'</p>	<p>PSHE Years 3 and 4 and Years 5 and 6 will both be looking at 'Keeping Safe' through Scarf and 'My Appreciate' through my Happy Mind during Term 2. Lessons will include 'Picture safety' and 'To share or not share'. As we move into Term 4 Years 3 and 4 and Years 5 and 6 will be looking at 'Rights and respect' through Scarf and 'Celebrate' from My Happy Mind. Through Picture News and Newsround we will keep up to date with national and worldwide issues.</p>
